Policy Title: COMMITTEES	Effective Date: April 12, 2005

The Board of Trustees may seek guidance from various advisory committees as one means of involving and gathering input from members of the community. Advisory committees may be appointed by the board when appropriate and will function in those areas assigned to it by the board. The Board reserves the right to create or establish the rules and regulations for creation and appointment of membership to its advisory committees. The central purpose of all advisory committees is limited to providing advice to the School Board by conducting studies, identifying problems, and developing options and recommendations that will enhance the decision-making process of the board.

The ultimate authority to make decisions, issue contracts, encumber funds, etc., continues to reside in the powers and duties of the Board as imposed by law. A staff member or members will be assigned to each committee to help it carry out its functions. Only the board has the authority to dissolve advisory committees it has created.

The board also authorizes the superintendent to form administrative advisory committees as needed.
