Snake River School District 52, by vote of the patrons, in accord with Idaho Code 33-2601, has established a Snake River School/Community Library District. The School/Community Library District is governed by a School/Community Library Board. All district libraries and/or instructional media centers are designated as School/Community libraries.

Each school building library is considered a "satellite" of the main community-school library housed at the high school. These satellite libraries are then public libraries and parents and patrons are encouraged to use these facilities anytime school is in session. These facilities may also be open in the summer on a rotating schedule based on recommendation by the District Library Director to the library board.

As Executive Officer of the Board of Trustees, the superintendent shall be responsible for executing the provisions of the school/community library contract.
