<p><b>The Snake River School District Board of Trustees recognizes that it has been entrusted to protect and maintain the publicly owned assets of the district. The most valuable assets in terms of dollar value are the buildings, grounds and contents of the buildings, both instructional and non-instructional. These assets are generically referred to as the physical plant of the district.</b></p> <p><b>The Board authorizes the Superintendent to gather information, create and maintain a long-range facility plan for the district. The Superintendent may utilize the services of those consultants, such as city, county or regional planners, as deemed necessary. The Board may consider recommendations for facility needs from citizens' advisory committees.
