Policy Title: Reporting Student Progress	Effective Date: February 27, 2008
<p>Parents shall be given a complete report of their student's progress several times during the school year. The report may include written and oral communication.</p> <p>Report cards will be issued six (6) time a year for students on the Trimester system and four (4) times a year for students on the Semester system.</p> <p>Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held at least twice annually. It is the responsibility of each teacher and administrator to inform parents and students of a student's progress. This is primarily done during the grade reporting period and Parent-Teacher Conferences. These reports are given to ensure that a student has every opportunity to be successful.
