School newspapers, yearbooks, and other school publications arising out of the curriculum shall be used for the training of students in the function of journalism and shall be consistent and in harmony with the standards of the community served by the school. School newspapers, yearbooks, and other publications shall be used to train individuals in reporting, layout, design, writing, and other areas unique to journalistic publications. Students will also be made aware of legal limitations of journalism as it relates to publications in the public forum. The goal of school publications, including yearbook and newspaper, is to provide quality publications which reflect newsworthy, accurate information to students, patrons, and the public in accordance with community standards, and to provide complete journalistic training to students of the Snake River School District 52.

School publications used for the above-stated purposes are not an open forum. All materials submitted for publication are subject to staff and administrative approval.
