Policy Title: Supportive Services	Effective Date: January 20, 2017

It is the policy of Snake River School District 52 to provide supportive services to learners exhibiting special needs to the extent determined by the district to be appropriate to their individual needs.

Supportive services in the Snake River School District 52 shall include Special Education, including all exceptional child programs as defined by Idaho Department of Education, Special Education, Section 504, Title 1, Title 1 Migrant, Limited English Proficiency and other similar programs.

Administrative guidelines are used to specify the operational procedure. These guidelines coincide with the various state and federal guidelines as they relate to each respective program. These guidelines provide for confidentiality and afford the least restrictive environment in the delivery of the designated supportive services for all students involved.

This policy will be administered in the most effective manner to maximize educational impact and use of available resources.
