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Policy Title: Special Education for Exceptional Children	Effective Date: November 20, 2019
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It is the policy of Snake River School District 52 to provide educational programming for exceptional children under the Individuals with Disability Education Act (IDEA). Handicapped students, ages 3 through 20, will be provided a free appropriate public education.

This board adopts as policy the *Idaho Special Education Manual 2018*, and all subsequent amendments to the manual as approved by the Idaho State Board of Education, for implementing the provisions of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
