1. WELCOME AND ROLL CALL

3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

4. BID RESULTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL GYMNASIUM BLEACHERS

The bleachers at the high school have been a safety issue and there is a need to replace them to make them compliant. A bid opening for the high school gymnasium bleachers was done at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 23, 2021. Bids were received from Montana School Equipment Company (Interkal) and Norcon Industries (Hussey Seating). We received a quote from ADP Lemco (Kodiak) before the bidding process began but they did not formally submit a bid. The bleacher committee met yesterday and checked the bids to make sure they met specifications. Tyler Watt was present to make a recommendation at board meeting. The bid for the general installation of the bleachers will be accepted with the understanding that there could be additional add-ons at a later time. The board is considering the idea of accepting design plans for additional costs. The board thanked each of the members of the committee for all of their time and hard work.

Lon Harrington moved and Larin Mortimer seconded I move to approve the bid from Norcon Industries in the amount of \$213,494 for removal of the old bleachers and installation of new bleachers in the main gymnasium at Snake River High School. All board members present voted aye. Motion passed 5-0.

A motion to adjourn was made by Marci VanOrden and seconded by Lon Harrington.
